Hazleton City Council Meeting
June 20th, 2018

Hazleton City Council meeting held at the City Hall called to order with the pledge of allegiance at 7:00 PM by Mayor Miller. Council members present, Hayzlett, Lujan, Michels & Seiffert, Vawter absent. Also present: City Clerk Baych, Public Works Loomis, Fire Chief Dettbarn & City Attorney Hosack. Lujan/Michels moved to approve the agenda, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Seiffert/Michels moved to approve the consent agenda: a) May 16th, 2018 minutes b) Clerk Report, c) Disbursements. Roll Call, All ayes, motion approved.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Pat Arthaud commented on the Legion countertops, thanked Vawter for his work on them and asked if the City could install a grab bar in the men's restroom. She questioned what's being down between the curb & sidewalk area where it was suppose to be seeded. She has only rocks and water grass. Darin Hayzlett thanked the council for their consideration to the open council seat.

BUCHANAN COUNTY SHERIFF DEPT: Deputy Buzynski onsite. The record of performance for the City of Hazleton was 86.38 hours with 77 records. Report on file.

HAZLETON FIRE DEPARTMENT: Dettbarn informed council on fire protection with being on central water during the duration of the water tower cleaning & painting.

PUBLIC WORKS: Council directed Loomis to place a bucket of dirt on Third Street and clean up sand on Hayes St W. Lujan/Seiffert moved to approve installation of NO PARKING signs at the Well House in City Park, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried.

CITY CLERK: Council directed Baych to remind residents on our Facebook of the ordinance regarding blowing cut grass into public streets. Michels /Hayzlett moved to approve City Clerk attend Municipal Professional Academy July 25th – 27th, Roll Call Michels yes, Hayzlett yes, Lujan no, Seiffert no, motion failed.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION/ACTION: Don Kleis with Prairie Road Builders addressed the council on his proposal on street repairs. Hayzlett/ Lujan moved to approve the proposal for \$16,868.20, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Dean Benter discussed his concerns regarding 211 Third St S. Jerry Snoble issue was resolved with Prairies Road Builders proposal. Julie Shebek with First American Site Acquisition is interested in having a US Cellular tower installed somewhere in the City of Hazleton. Hosack will research the possibilities. Howard Mace addressed the council on the problems he is having with feral cats in his neighborhood. Hayzlett/Michels moved to appoint Lujan to the Parks Committee, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried. Seiffert/Lujan moved to amend Resolution 18-04 Signatures for city accounts and add Hayzlett to the accounts, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Michels/Hayzlett moved to approve Fat Boy's Liquor License, Roll Call, All Ayes, Motion approved. Lujan/Seiffert moved to approve painting a ring at the bottom of the tower with the same color the lettering Hazleton is in. Seiffert stated that was a burgundy color for \$8,000.00, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried. Hayzlett/Lujan moved to approve the Maguire Iron service contract for the water tower, All Ayes, motion approved. Hayzlett/Lujan moved to approve the power washing and roof painting of City Hall to AJAJ Painting & Renovation for \$2,600.00, Roll Call All Ayes, motion approved. Seiffert/Lujan moved to approve the ditch repair and Bennett culvert on First St S to Smith Excavating for \$11,350.00, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried. A discussion on a tree removal & mowing Benton St W. Mayor Miller will contact Alliant Energy to see if they will take whole tree down. Hayzlett will look into the repair of the grill at City Park. Lujan/Hayzlett moved to approve No Overnight Parking at the fishing area on South Street, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Seiffert/Hayzlett moved to approve Resolution 18-10 INRCOG Safety Program, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried. Hayzlett/Seiffert moved to cash in the Skate Park CD, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried. Hayzlett/Michels moved to approve Resolution 18-11 – Year End Transfers, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Hayzlett/Lujan moved to approve Resolution 18-12 – Fire Truck CD, Roll Call, All Ayes, Motion approved. Hayzlett/Michels moved to approve Resolution 18-13 – Sludge CD, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Lujan/Hayzlett moved to approve 18-14 – Water

Tower CD, Roll Call, All Ayes, Motion approved. Hayzlett/Lujan moved to set a public hearing for July 18th to increase water/sewer rates according to CPI, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion carried. Hayzlett/Michels moved to approve Resolution 18-09 Fire Chief & Part-time Pay Increase, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Hayzlett/Michels moved to approve Resolution 18-07 – City Clerk Pay increase 1%, Roll Call, All Ayes, motion approved. Lujan/Michels moved to approve Resolution 18-08 – Public Works Pay Increase 1%, Roll Call All Ayes, motion approved.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT: Hosack updated council on pending court cases.

MAYOR REPORT: Miller informed council on Vawter’s condition.
