Discussion on Speeding Cameras for the City. The City will be setting up meetings to hear proposals before the next Council meeting. There is no update on the ATV/UTV ordinance. Water meter updates are underway. We are working with the City Engineer for proposals.

ACTION & DISCUSSION ITEMS

Updates were given on insurance premiums and how increases have affected the city. There was discussion on garbage being placed in the gravelly areas and how the garbage trucks can damage them. The council will be looking into different options. Public Works brought up when do we want to open the Public Bathrooms and fix any damages that were caused from winter. No dates were set. Spring Clean up will be May 14th.
